Registration Information

Registration begins March 22, 2010 for YMCA Members and March 25, 2010 for Program Participants. A \$25 annual registration fee is due for all children who are not currently registered in YMCA Child Development school year programs (unless otherwise noted for some specialty camps).

Each camp has a limited number of spaces and registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Camps may be cancelled due to insufficient enrollment. Participants must meet the minimum age requirements by June 7, 2010 and may not exceed the maximum age requirements before July 12, 2010.

Payment Information

A non-refundable, non-transferable \$10 deposit for each week is required to reserve a space for your child, unless noted otherwise. Camp fees are due on the WEDNESDAY prior to each registered session, unless you sign up for automatic weekly bank draft. Please see registration form for deposit/payment policies.
